WHAT IS THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S INTERNATIONAL AWARD?

WE EQUIP, EMPOWER, CONNECT AND TRANSFORM THE LIVES OF YOUNG PEOPLE

Each person that does The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award learns a skill, becomes physically active, volunteers in their community and undertakes a team adventure.

Open to young people aged 14 to 24, the Award is offered in over 130 countries worldwide and is available at Bronze, Silver and Gold levels, which are progressively more challenging.

In Australia over 40,000 young people are engaged in the program annually, supported by a network of over 60,000 adult volunteers.

Through this challenging journey of self-discovery, Participants are equipped and empowered to achieve their personal best, to take ownership of their own goals and life choices and become actively engaged within their community and workforce.

The Award can be found right across Australia in government and independent schools, universities, prisons and youth detention centres, indigenous communities, new refugee support programs, in cities, rural and remote areas, government departments and in community organisations such as surf life saving, disability groups and other youth programs.

THE FINANCIAL FACTS

It costs \$3.9m to operate the Award throughout Australia

- 60% is from Participant and Award Unit registrations
- 20% from donors & sponsors
- 20% from Government (State & Territory) project grants
- > Award Registration fees range from \$145 to \$185

> Each year, over 800 Participants receive special assistance funding to commence and/or complete their Award, including funding from Ambassadors and sponsors
