Award Updates 2023

The following changes to the ORB relate to the Award Updates 2023 which have been communicated previously. Here, we outline the relevant changes to the ORB with release 2.16 as well as changes made in previous updates.


1. Participants age and Gold Award approval

Applies to: All users

Problem: Part of the recent Award updates, it states that: For Silver Award holders progressing to the Gold Award, there should be no age restriction. However, Gold participants cannot achieve their Gold Award before their 16th birthday.

Solution: Awards can be submitted by participants and authorised by Award Leaders however final Award sign off (by Award Office or Award Verifier cannot be actioned until the participant has turned 16).

A red error message will appear during Award sign off stating "This participant is not yet 16 years old - you can approve this award from {date}"



Participants will also see a message when submitting the Award to the Award Leader, "Please note, that you're Award cannot be signed-off until you are 16 years of age."

Note: You have completed all sections of your Award. You can now submit it to your Award Leader for Authorisation. You can also add a personal note below.

Please note, that your Award cannot be signed-off until you are 16 years of age.


This change will be revisited once it's released, to understand the amount of Gold participants under the age of 16 and how this is effecting NAOs management of Award approvals.

2. Updates to AJ mode of transport

Applies to: All users creating AJs

There are two new updates being applied to the mode of transport in Adventurous Journey.

- The ability to select more than one AJ mode of transport in set up.
- There will be one category of 'Animal' which will replace Camel, Donkey and Horse (note that these were used on a very limited basis previously)



The Apps will be updated to reflect this change with the release (estimated for 21 August)

3. Adventurous Journey: 'Aim' replaced with 'Team Goal'

Applies to: All users creating AJ's

To provide consistency in the terminology across the Award and bring the Adventurous Journey in line with the other sections, the term 'Aim' is being replaced with 'Team Goal' this new term emphasises the collective nature of the AJ section, where the goal should be developed and completed as a team.

If you are using a specific language for the ORB you will need to adjust this within POEditor. Information for which can be found here.

Other Changes with release 2.16

The following are other changes within the ORB that arent related to the Award Updates.


4. Ability for Award Leader to view/download Section Summary of Participant

Applies to: Users at Operator and Award Centre level

Problem: If an external assessor is not responding to ORB emails, Award Leaders need to be able to download a section summary for participants so the Assessor can complete on paper if needed.

Solution: There will be an opportunity for an Award Leader to *Download Section Summary.* This allows Assessors to complete on paper.

This Feature will be available from the relevant *Activity* tab.



Next Steps:

This feature will be added to the Adventurous Journey and Gold Residential Project. This will be something addressed in future releases.


5. Award Leaders able to filter Participants based on Last Log Added data

Applies to: Users at Award Centre level

Problem: Although the *Last Log Added* appears in the participant list views for an Award Leader, it is not sortable and so there is no way of organising participants by when they were active on the ORB.

Solution: In order to give Award Leaders better opportunity to view participant activity there will be an option to filter participants within certain dates of the *Last Log Added* field.

Participants who have registered logs within that date range will then be displayed alphabetically.




6. Adding Participant Labels to Award level


Applies to: Users at Award Operator level

Problem: The current participant labels are applied to a participant throughout their Award journey, staying with them as they move on to higher Award levels. In many situations this will be needed. However, for some operators, there is a need to add labels relating to participation in a specific Award Level.

Solution: A customisation to allow NAOs to choose which type of label they wish Award Centres to use. This customisation can be turned on in the same way as the other label options, which are now separated into a Labels tab within customisation:



These labels will be visible on the assigned participant but only if they are still currently achieving that award. *For example*, a participant who had an Award Level Label for their Bronze Level but is now on their Silver, it will not be present in the participant tab. However, it will be present in the details of the Bronze Award for that particular participant.



7. AJ files uploaded in observation, viewable for Award Leader

Applies to: Award Leaders

Problem: AJ files added by the participant under *Observation* (when submitting AJ to assessor) do not appear for Award Leaders.

Solution: Files appearing under *Additional Files* in both the Practice and Qualifying AJ's to also appear in the *Documents* tab viewable by Award Leader.



Next steps:

• Request to add observation notes also (not just files).


8. Messaging function for Award Leader

Applies to: Award Leaders

The new messaging function brings the following two new features:

- 1. Ability to add comments (instructions, encouraging words) on individual activity logs;
- 2. Send messages to selected Participants via in-ORB notification and/or email

9. New Activity for Financial Literacy

Applies to: Participants/ Award Leaders

After a request from an NAO working with a partner organisation to support Financial Literacy, a new activity has been added, Financial Literacy, which can be found in the *Skills* section with the following sub-headings;

- Financial Literacy/Money Management
- Investing
- Advertising
- Financial Fraud
- Crypto currencies
- Risks and Hazards

- Behavioural Economics
- Budgeting
- Social Economy
- Green Economy
- Other

And in *Voluntary Service:*

Financial Literacy (under existing Education activity.

Note that the Activity *Money Management,* was under *Life and Vocational Skills* but has been migrated under this new Activity heading and renamed *Financial Literacy/Money Management*.

Next steps: Next year, we will be undertaking a more holistic review of section activities on the ORB, with the view of enabling both customisation for Operators and to reduce the use of 'Other' categories being selected. The latter being an issue with reporting and identifying patterns and trends in activity choices.
