We have a **zero-tolerance** approach to child abuse, and any allegations or concerns will be taken very seriously. We follow robust policies and procedures to address and resolve issues swiftly and consistently.

As part of our commitment to child safety, we adhere to our **legal, moral and mandatory obligations** to report concerns to the appropriate authorities whenever a child's safety is at risk. We actively work to **prevent abuse** by identifying potential risks early, taking steps to reduce those risks, and ensuring a safe environment for all involved.

We also prioritise **mandatory regular training and education** for our board members, staff, and volunteers, helping them recognise and respond to child protection issues.

Additionally, we are committed to **cultural safety** for all children and young people, including Aboriginal children, children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, and children with disabilities. We are dedicated to providing an inclusive environment where every young person feels respected, supported, and safe.
